Objectives include:

- Offer consultation to the LGBTQ community
- Connect the above populations to local, state, and federal resources
- Provide 2-3 annual trainings for the public
- Speak at 1-2 annual conferences relating to Christian and/or LGBTQ populations
- Table, attend, speak at local organizations and events relating to Christian and/or LGBTQ populations

Board members meet 1-2 times a month for the purpose of planning events, fundraising, and executing the objectives of the organization. Attendance at board meetings can be in-person or virtual. Decisions are agreed upon according to Robert’s Rules of Order in a meeting with no fewer than a majority of directors present. Board members are assigned for terms of one year, and no member may hold the same position for more than three consecutive terms.
